The cash balance in our checking/savings account is \$1,356,000, we have \$913,000 in restricted net assets, and a net equity position of \$11,074,391 Mark shared with council that there were some late year lump sum gifts that gave WLC a year end suprlus of \$589,000. The surplus was used to pay down debt, support mission work, increase longterm capital	
	accounts. The current mortgage balance is \$324,000	
	Mark shared with council some of the capital projects being planned for 2022. Organ cleaning, landscape project at Oakhill, replacing the sound system at Valley Creek, Wakota Ridge HVAC, carpets and lights.

Annual meeting discussion:	~100 people attended the annual meeting in person and an additional 200 attended online. The meeting content was upbeat and made for more of a celebration than just a meeting. Using the annual meeting to share with the congregation what WLC is doing now and what direction we are gong in the future is impactful. The meeting duration was discussed and council felt it was appropriate. Having the financial meeting ahead of the annual meeting gives those that are more interested in the churches finances an opportunity to learn more and ask questions.
