Multisite Consent agenda: Minutes: Financials:	 Pastor Jon Kuehne presented the results of an Executive Feasibility Study of a merger with Concordia St. Paul Our WLC staff has continued meeting with leaders of Concordia St. Paul. After much discussion and detailed analysis, the recommendation is that we move forward in pursuing a merger. A motion was made to accept the recommendations of the Executive Feasibility Summary for the WLC-Concordia SSP site and to endorse continued actions by staff and members to continue working through details. Town hall meetings will be scheduled to discuss details with the congregation before bringing forward a vote to the congregation. September Meeting minutes were reviewed by council Mark Stutelberg reported to the council that September financials ended with income of \$ 222,270 against expenses of \$244,704 for a net negative income of \$22,434. YTD ordinary income is exceeding expenses by \$56,804. The preschool for calendar year 2020 to date has an income of \$343,749 against expenses of \$353,422 for a net loss of \$9,673. Preschool support from Church has been \$14,575 to date against a budget of \$43,75.
