How will you respond?

I'm a skeptic.	I'm on the fence.	I believe Jesus rose!
What if it's true that Jesus rose from the dead? How would your view of life change?	What holds you back from believing in Jesus? What would it take to convince you to believe?	Do you find yourself believing in the principles that Jesus taught or in Jesus as Lord and Savior? Is there a difference? Why or why not?
Everyone has faith in something. What do you have faith in today?	Do you believe you need Jesus in your life? Why or why not?	Are you ready for Jesus to come back again?

A challenge for each response:

I'm a skeptic.

Can the things you have faith in today hold you up when you're sick? When someone has wronged you? When you fail? When you come across something you don't understand or can't explain?

I'm on the fence.

This week, pray that Jesus would show you that he's alive. Keep your eyes open!

I believe Jesus rose!

Jesus' teaching was all about himself. When we see what Jesus valued it was his relationship with his Father (WORSHIP), a close friendship with his disciples (GROW), and pouring into the hurting and broken around him (SERVE & REACH). How does your life model these values? In what area might Jesus be calling you to take a next step?
