Distance Preschool Details

Virtual preschool will be coordinated by Shannon Schach. Miss Shannon will bring her experience with technology and hands-on preschool learning to create opportunities for your child to be successful during this important time. Craft packets/learning packets would be assembled and delivered to your home (within 10 miles of Woodbury) or you can make other arrangements with the school. They come with nearly all supplies for your child to complete the activities. Zoom meetings (virtual classroom) would be done in a way that encourages active participation from your child as well as outlines shared with you so you can assist them in being prepared. Learning videos will be uploaded to a private group where you can access them and these can be done at your pace and at the time of day that is best for you. Learning opportunities align with experiences children would have in face to face preschool.

Distance Learning Options

Craft Kit

- Includes 4 crafts per month as well as the necessary supplies for your child to complete these activities.
- Instructions are provided via written directions.

\$25 per month

Craft Kit & Video

- Includes 8 crafts per month which include the necessary supplies for your child to complete these activities.
- Video instructions are provided along with written instruction sheet. Video Instructions allow children to more independently complete the project on their own.

\$68 per month

Learning Combo 1

- Includes 4 crafts per month including supplies, written and video instructions.
- Three video lessons per week covering math, literacy and Bible time. Corresponding learn at home materials will also be provided.
- Weekly chatroom time of approximately 20-25 minutes to promote social / emotional development, reinforcement of skills and comfort sharing in a group.

\$150 per month

Learning Combo 2

- Includes 8 crafts per month including supplies, written and video instructions.
- Four video lessons per week covering math, literacy, Bible time as well as time with movement, music and science each month. Corresponding learn at home materials will also be provided.
- Weekly chatroom time of approximately 20-25 minutes to promote social / emotional development, reinforcement of skills and comfort sharing in a group.
- One on one chatroom time of 10-15 minutes weekly and a once a month 10-15 minute parent session/assessment update

\$250 per month

Other Notes Regarding Virtual Preschool

- Families will enroll sessions. Families sign up for the full-session; changes can be made at session breaks.. Sessions are October, November-December, January-March and April-May.
- Initial materials will be provided (families will need to provide some hole punch, stapler, tape).
- Families are responsible for providing technology devices.
- There is not a registration fee, however tuition is due at the beginning of the month for the current month and families are responsible for payment for the full session which they are enrolled
- Add on craft kits are available for \$10 (LC1) and \$20 (LC2) to allow siblings to complete these activities, too!
- Current in-person families may add a virtual option to their in-person experience for 20% off the rate listed above.
